Informal debate	The delegates of each country sitting around one table debate the motion within their group. They take notes and prepare their contributions to the open discussion of the general assembly.	7 min	11:02 – 11:09
Open debate	The President opens the debate to the floor and everyone can participate in the following debate. A delegate who wants to speak raises his country's name tag and will be called upon by the Presidency to speak.	20 min	11:09 – 11:29
Seconder of the Proposer's speech	Seconder counters the arguments of the opposing side and reacts to the Open Debate.	3 min	11:29 –11:32
Voting	Each country decides by majority rule whether the motion will be carried and then casts its vote. The votes are counted by the Chair.	10min	11:32– 11:42
Result	President communicates the result to the general assembly.	5 min	11:42– 11:47

Announcement of 2 nd resolution	Member of Committee: Motion, for example: “Should the European Union forbid smoking in all public facilities including restaurants?”	2 min	11:57 – 11:59
