| Procedure | President introduces the Chair and the Committee and explains the procedure of the debate and its rules. | Introductory speech | Speaker reads the resolution. | 3 min | 10:38 – 10:41 |
| Question time | Delegates from the floor may ask factual questions which will be answered by the Committee. | 15min | 10:41 – 10:56 |
| Proposer’s speech | Proposer presents arguments in favour of the motion | 3min | 10:56 – 10:59 |
| Opposer’s speech | Opposer speaks against the motion. | 3min | 10:59– 11:02 |
| Informal debate | The delegates of each country sitting around one table debate the motion within their group. They take notes and prepare their contributions to the open discussion of the general assembly. | 7 min | 11:02 – 11:09 |
| Open debate | The President opens the debate to the floor and everyone can participate in the following debate. A delegate who wants to speak raises his country’s name tag and will be called upon by the Presidency to speak. | 20 min | 11:09 – 11:29 |
| Seconder of the Proposer’s speech | Seconder counters the arguments of the opposing side and reacts to the Open Debate. | 3 min | 11:29 –11:32 |
| Voting | Each country decides by majority rule whether the motion will be carried and then casts its vote. The votes are counted by the Chair. | 10min | 11:32– 11:42 |
| Result | President communicates the result to the general assembly. | 5 min | 11:42– 11:47 |
| Break | | 10min | 11:47 – 11:57 |
| Announcement of 2nd resolution | Member of Committee: Motion, for example: “Should the European Union forbid smoking in all public facilities including restaurants?” | 2 min | 11:57 – 11:59 |
| Proposer’s speech | Proposer presents arguments in favour of the motion. | 3 min | 11:59 – 12:02 |
| Opposer’s speech | Opposer speaks against the motion. | 3 min | 12:02 – 12:05 |
| Open debate | Every delegate may participate. | 18 min | 12:05– 12:23 |
| Seconder of the Proposer’s speech | Seconder backs up the Proposer and reacts to the Open Debate. | 3 min | 12:23 - 12:26 |
| Voting | Countries’ delegations cast their votes. | 8min | 12:26 – 12:34 |
| Result | President announces the result. | 2 min | 12:34 – 12:36 |
